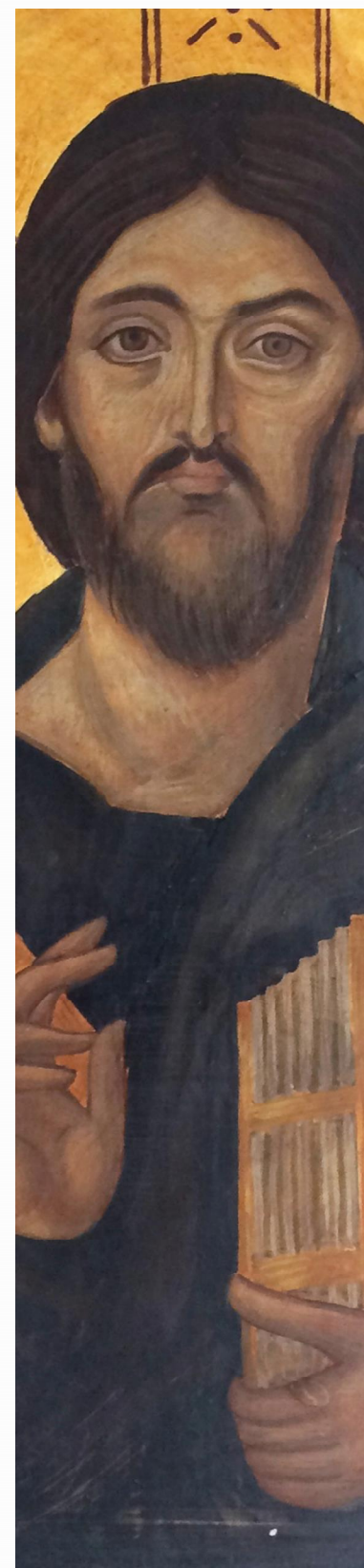

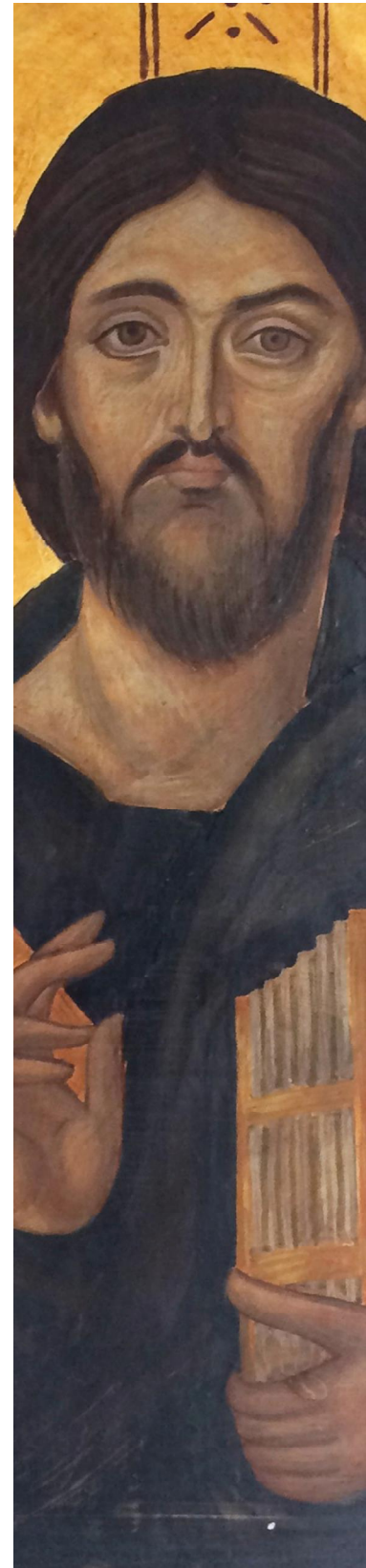

From the Director of CITI....

In serving the requirements of the bishops and the needs of the church, the Theological Institute aims to provide a wide range of training courses and meeting opportunities for both clergy and lay people. Coming and going on a regular basis are readers (both serving and in training), school principals, university chaplains, children's ministry personnel, the Church of Ireland Youth Department, mission agencies, military chaplains, curates, internship Rectors, Wardens, Directors of Ordinands, bishops, other clergy, other college groups and participants in lay programmes.

Yet for all that, the mainstay of the Institute's existence and purpose continues to be the delivery of ordination training. Over the past year two new developments warrant particular mention. The Institute has recently undergone a rigorous process of two separate reviews. The report of the first of these, externally driven as a statutory requirement, is available for any who may wish to read it on the TCD website. As a result of one of the various recommendations in the report the MTh

course is being restructured in order to allow for more extensive teaching in biblical studies and doctrine, and so that the part-time course can be reduced in length from six to four years. The restructured course will take effect from autumn 2017. The second review was conducted by a team appointed by the House of Bishops.

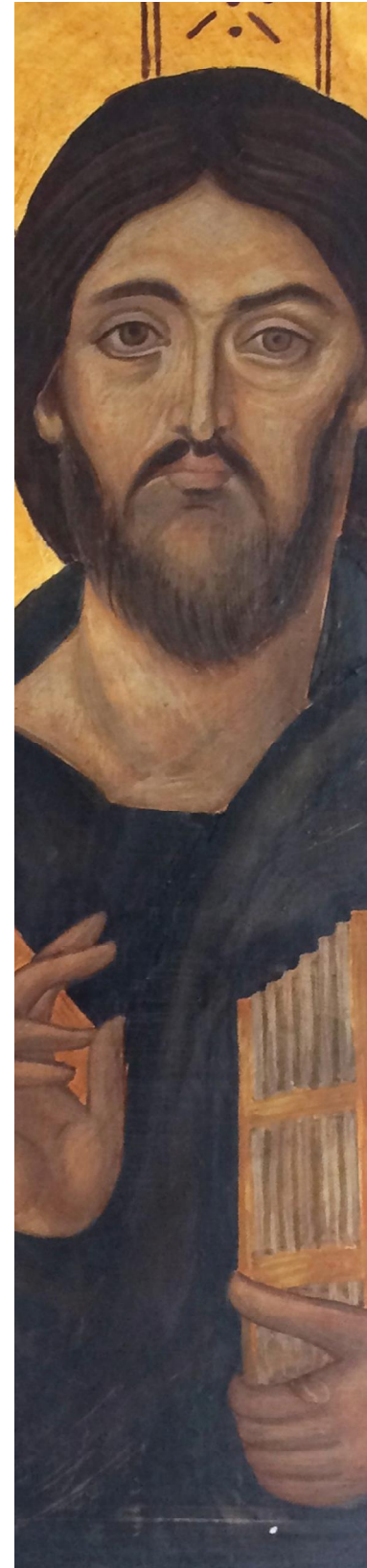
The other significant development has been a decision of the General Synod to endorse a resolution from the Commission on Ministry to move in the direction of Ordained Local Ministry. The precise nature and outworking of this new pathway is presently with the Archbishops and Bishops for their final consideration. As usual the details of those who are currently in training are given elsewhere in this newsletter, and I know that I speak on behalf of all the staff in saying that it remains a great privilege to serve the church in working with people of such calibre, faith and commitment to the cause of Jesus Christ.
